




AGREEMENT CONCERNING YOUR TREATMENT DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

the following has been agreed:

- The prospective parent(s) has (have) requested to start a treatment at the LUFC despite the COVID-19 pandemic.
- The prospective parent(s) has (have) been informed that there is very limited information on the impact of a corona infection on eggs, sperm cells and embryos. Until so far, there is no evidence of transmission of the virus to eggs or sperm cells. Transmission of the virus during the last trimester of the pregnancy has been described in women with a COVID-19 infection. Until now, no consequences for the neonates have been observed. However, long term data are not yet available. Data on the consequences of a Corona infection during early pregnancy are not available until so far. There is even less information available on the risk of transmission of the virus to eggs, sperm cells or embryos in a laboratory. During your treatment LUFC will not deviate from the current standard clinical practice and operating procedures in the laboratory in order to minimize the risk of transmission of the virus to eggs, sperm cells or embryos in the laboratory.
- The prospective parent(s) consent(s) to start a treatment under preventive measures aiming to reduce the spread of the corona virus. These measures are subjective to change, possibly during the treatment and consequently, the course of treatment may differ from that initially consented between LUFC and the prospective parent(s);
- The prospective parent(s) is (are) requested to notify LUFC as swiftly as possible in case they develop symptoms of a COVID-19 infection, such as fever, dry cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, loss of smell or taste, fatigue, muscle pain or diarrhea. The LUFC will check this during the treatment. At the slightest suspicion of a COVID-19 infection, the treatment will not start or will be cancelled immediately.
- Despite the preventive measures, the COVID-19 pandemic may involve risks that are not yet known to us.
- The prospective parent(s) declare(s) that she (they) has (have) been properly informed by the LUFC and hereby consent(s) to start a treatment during the COVID-19 pandemic.
